In 1928 when Taiwan was under Japanese rule, the Kagi Agriculture and Forestry Public School (a.k.a KANO, short for its Japanese name KAGI-NORIN School) was established to help develop local agriculture. The KANO baseball team started out simply as a sports club to improve the students' physique. It never occurred to them that the arrival of Coach Kondo would completely transform the team into a legend.

To every young baseball player, Koshien, Japan's high school baseball championship, was like a dream palace. For a group of farmer boys like the KANO team, it was a goal far beyond their reach. However, with coach Kondo's extremely rigorous training and appreciation of the members' various strengths, he motivated the determined, multicultural team (Japanese, Taiwanese, and aboriginal) to win the local championship and make it to the final game.

Facing the strongest team in the league, the KANO team rises to the challenge together as one.
