In 2005, Director Yamazaki Takashi's *Sunset on Third Street* won 12 Japan Academy Awards. Yamazaki brought Saigan Ryohei's long-running manga to the big screen with the help of cutting-edge visual effects, recreating Japan's post-war years with a healthy dose of nostalgia.

Now Yamazaki adapts another of Saigan's most popular works. Original story Kamakura Monogatari (Kamakura Story) has been in print for 30 years, with 9.1 million copies published, and 34 collected editions. In Yamazaki's hands, it has become one of the greatest Japanese cinematic fantasies ever.

When young Akiko marries mystery author Isshiki Masakazu and moves in with him in Kamakura, her way of life becomes a constant source of amazement. A simple stroll through the streets brings her into contact with supernatural creatures such as spirits, goblins, ghosts, and "not grim-at-all" reapers.

As Akiko learns very quickly, Kamakura is a place where humans and non-humans live side-by-side in harmony. The Isshiki residence is also home to a parade of other distinctive and unusual denizens. Although Akiko's newlywed lifestyle isn't quite as she'd imagined, it still turns out to be a lot of hectic fun.

But the story of these newlyweds takes an unfortunate turn one morning when Akiko suddenly disappears!
