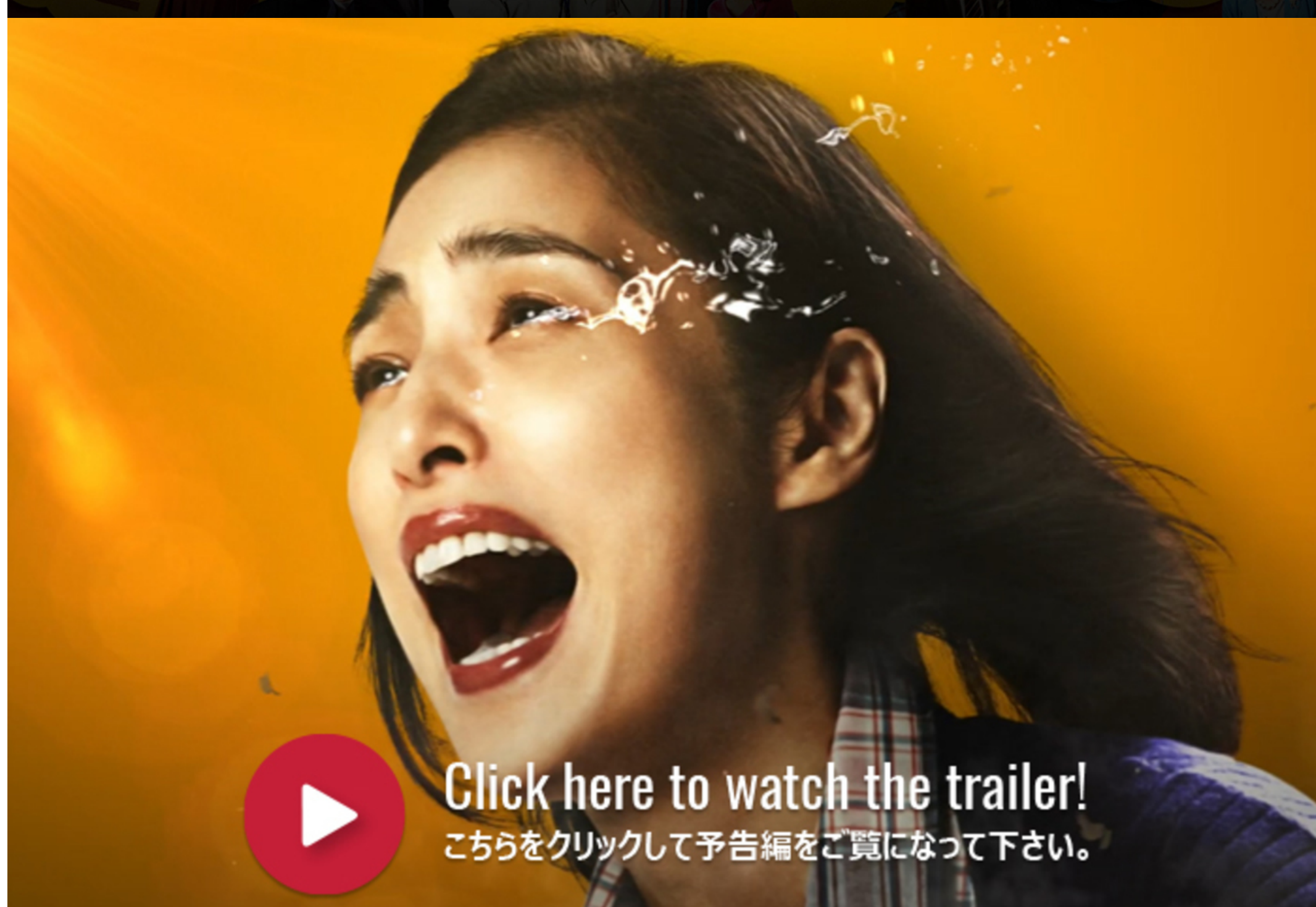

Our next J-Film is the hit comedy What Happened to Our Nest Egg!? Adapted from KAKIYA Miu's bestselling novel, this zany and energetic family comedy came to the big screen in the fall of 2021 courtesy of director MAEDA Tetsu.

How much money do you need to retire? In Japan, **20 million yen** is said to be the recommended amount that you need to comfortably retire. But how do you actually go about saving that money? This comedy looks at a very relatable (and somewhat dysfunctional) family as they try to tackle various financial obstacles that keep popping up one after another.

Atsuko (AMAMI Yuki) is a frugal housewife who manages the finances for the family. Her husband **Akira** (played by MATSUSHIGE Yutaka who you may recognize from Netflix hit *Midnight Diner*) is clueless about the family budget, while her daughter is busy working a part-time job and her son is studying at college. Atsuko had been saving up for retirement, but after an argument with her sister-in-law, a massive and unexpected bill lands on her desk! That is only the beginning and as their financial problems start piling up, so do their hijinks.

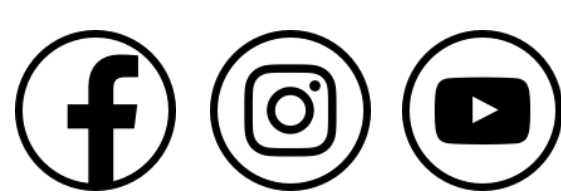
