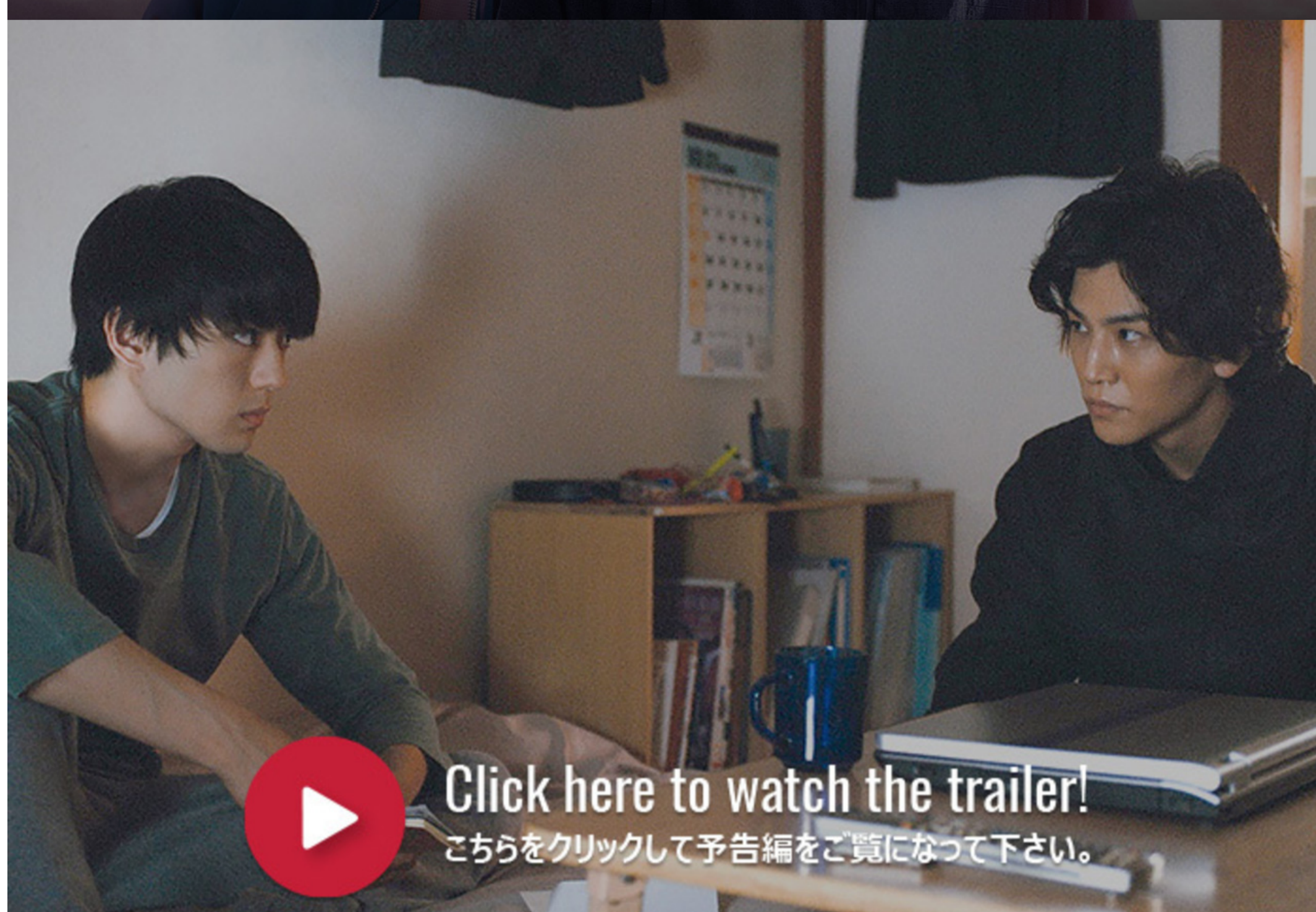

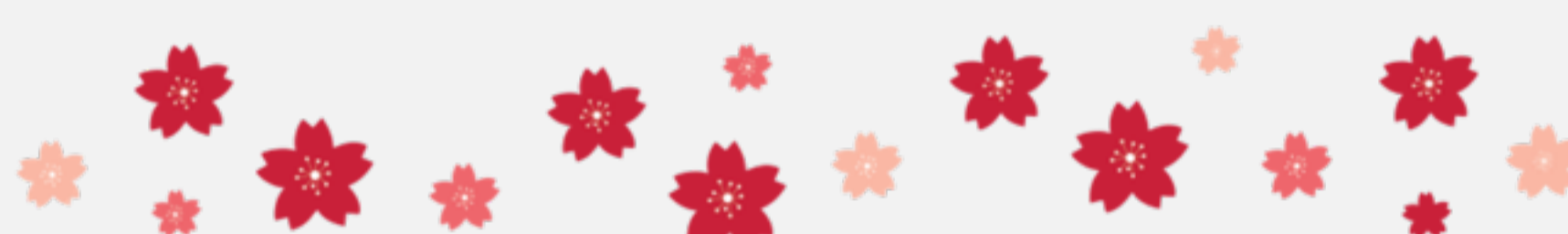

Our next J-Film is the suspense thriller *The Master Plan*.

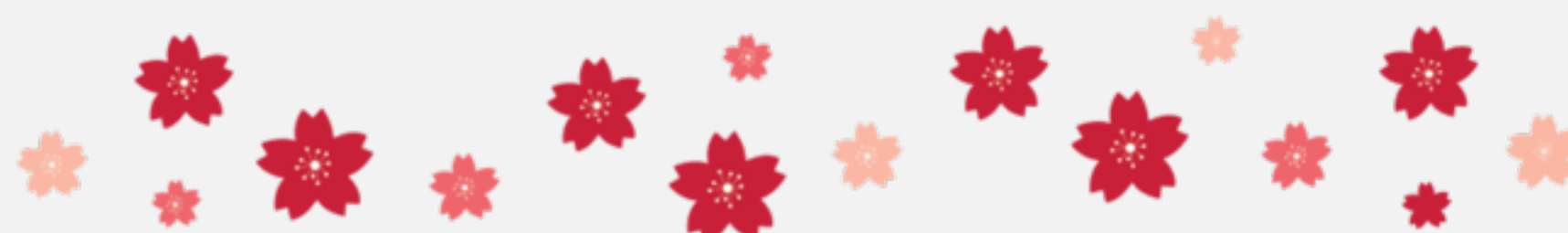
