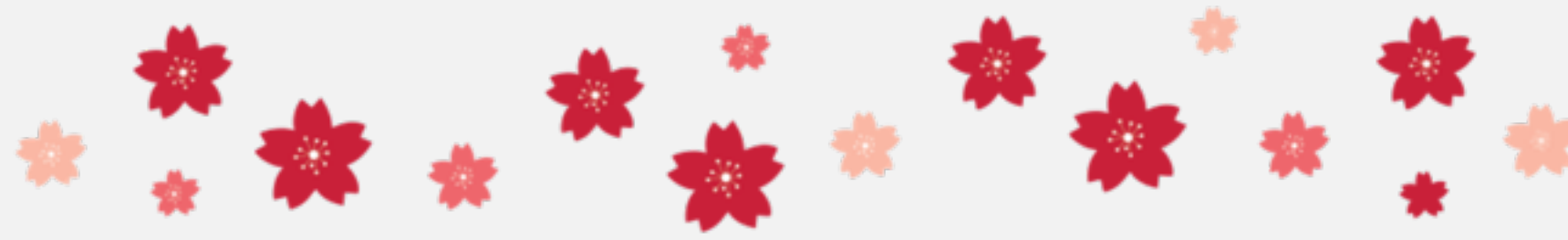

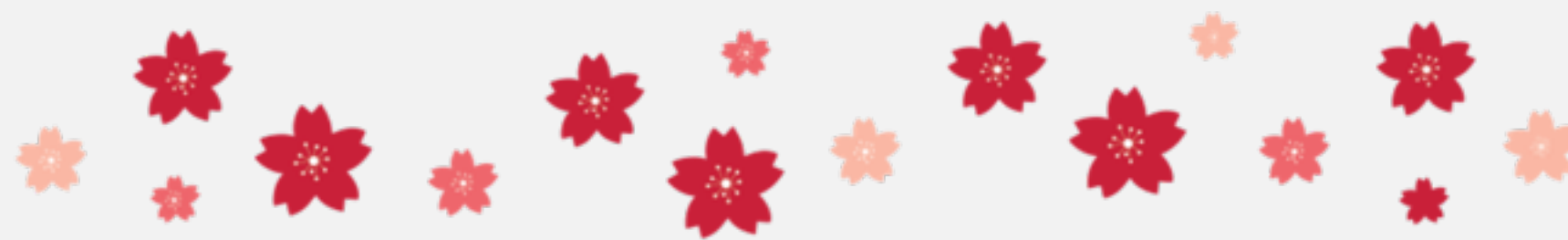
Our next J-Film is the touching coming-of-age story *Nagi's Island*.

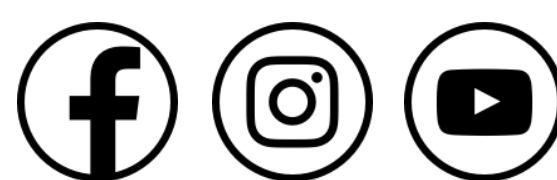
