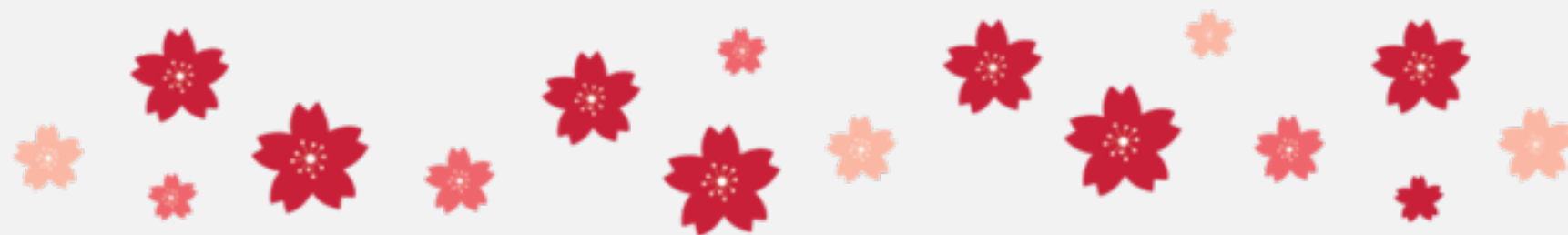

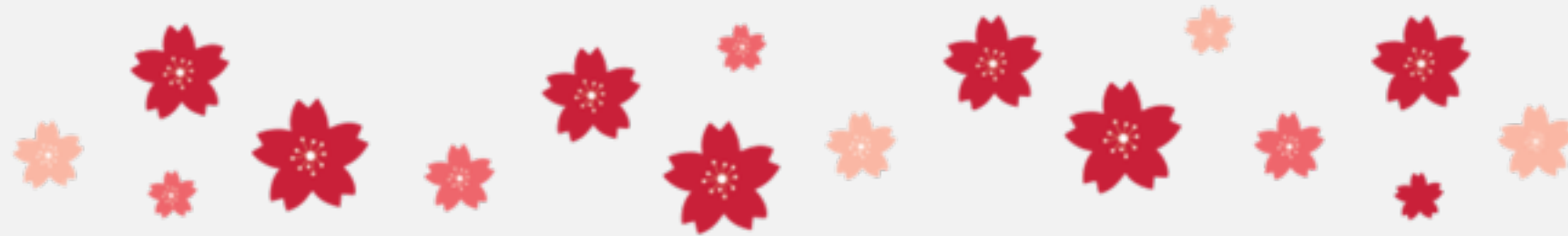
Our J-Film for the Halloween season, *The Good Father*, is both delightfully suspenseful and a little scary.
